This year's Grand Marshal for the Electric Christmas Parade is St. Charles native, Chris Witaske. Chris Witaske has held many acting roles in shows including Emmy-winning FX original series The Bear, Netflix original comedy series Love, and a recurring role in the popular "Turning into Your Parents" Progressive Insurance commercials, to name a few. The Community Guest of Honor for the Electric Christmas Parade is St. Charles resident, Deborah Foote, who was instrumental in starting this annual tradition in 2001.

To ensure everyone's enjoyment at this year's Electric Christmas Parade, a special viewing area will be designated by the front parking lot at the St. Charles Muniicpal Center for those with mobility limitations. This area can be identified by the blue "Reserved Seating" signage.

Also taking place in conjunction with Small Business Saturday is the St. Charles Holiday Shop Crawl. 
