Entry Form Deadline Has Been Extended for the 2025 St. Charles Scarecrow Contest

- Clubs/Not-For-Profit/Schools Category – Open to all clubs, not-for-profits, and school.
- Individual Category – Open to all individuals and families not affiliated with a business or organization.

For the business Category, Clubs/Not-for-Profit/Schools Category, and the Individual Category, prizes are 1st Place: \$200, 2nd Place: \$150, and 3rd Place: \$100. For the Mega/Mechanical Category, prizes are 1st Place: \$500, 2nd Place: \$350, and 3rd Place: \$250.
