ST. CHARLES, IL – The STC Six is launching their third-annual collaborative beer. The STC Six is made up of all six St. Charles Breweries: 93 Octane Brewery, Alter Brewing + Kitchen, Broken Brix Fermentation Emporium, D&G Brewing, Pollyanna Brewing & Distilling, and Riverlands Brewing. The breweries invite everyone to help celebrate the launch with the first opportunity to taste the new beer on June 12th starting at 5pm at Alter Brewing + Kitchen – 12 S. 1st St., St. Charles, IL 60174.

Riverlands Brewing's Head Brewer/Co-Founder, Eric Bramwell, speaks on the style of beer that was created for this year's STC Six. "The STC Six 2024 is a California Common. A hybrid style, California Common, or "steam beer," ferments with lager yeast at warmer temperatures," says Bramwell. "One of the only truly American indigenous styles of beer as it was created in San Francisco. Rustic woody and herbal Northern Brewer hops play well with the buscuity and caramel malt flavors."

One dollar from every sale of the STC Six Collaborative Beer and the limited-edition glassware will go towards STC L.E.A.R.N., a local non-profit that partners with D303 students and families to access equal learning and academic opportunities.
