## The Luck of the Irish is Coming to the St. Charles St. Patrick's Parade

ST. CHARLES, IL – The St. Charles St. Patrick's Parade, presented by St. Charles Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, Ram, is taking place in downtown St. Charles on March 9<sup>th</sup>, along with an array of family-friendly St. Patrick's-themed activities for individuals to take part in around town.

The downtown festivities kick-off at 11am with the Opening Ceremony on the 1<sup>st</sup> Street Plaza (near Gia Mia and McNally's Irish Pub & Kitchen), in partnership with McNally's Irish Pub & Kitchen. On March 14<sup>th</sup>, three lucky winners will be selected to win (2 Pots of Gold are valued at \$100, 1 Pot of Gold is valued at \$300), and contacted via email.

At 2pm, the St. Patrick's Parade will step off at 6<sup>th</sup> Street and will travel down Main Street to conclude at 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Visitors will get to experience the sounds of Bagpipers, listen to local award-winning marching bands, and watch the elaborate and colorful parade entries all while being surrounded by the Irish-themed excitement.

To capture the memorable time at the St. Patrick's Parade, there will be a Lucky Photo Station, sponsored by McNally's Heating & Cooling, located on Riverside Avenue across from Pollyanna Brewing & Distilling.
